"Russian Archbishop Tadeusz Kondruchewicz Crowns the IPVS In Fatima, Portugal"

Among the more than half a million people who gathered at Fatima in October of 2007 for the 90th Anniversary of the Miracle of the Sun, was Archbishop Tadeusz Kondruchewicz, the first Catholic bishop consecrated in Russia in the post Communist era. He had been consecrated Archbishop of Moscow in 1991.

Also on pilgrimage to Fatima for the commemorations were two directors of the International Pilgrim Virgin Foundation, Carl Malburg and Thomas McKenna. They were accompanying the Pilgrim Virgin Statue. They were excited and honored to meet the illustrious Archbishop and attend an early morning Mass he celebrated in the Chapel of the Apparitions for a group of Russian pilgrims accompanying him. Archbishop Kondruchewicz was pleased with



the presence of the famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima which he recalled had visited his diocese in 1992.

When he learned that the statue was present, he asked that the statue be placed on a pillar in front of the altar which is very near where Our Lady had actually appeared in 1917. During his sermon, Archbishop Kondruchewicz spoke of his absolute faith and trust in Mary's promise of the conversion of Russia, and of his own devotion to Our Lady of Fatima. At one point the Archbishop choked up with tears as he spoke fervently about Our Lady's promise for his country.

He had been present in October, 1992 when the statue was brought on pilgrimage to Red square in Moscow.

"The Chastisement"

In January 1992, an amazing meeting took place in Havana, Cuba. World leaders were given the opportunity to see just how close the world had come to a nuclear war. Former U.S. Secretary of Defense McNamara, who took part in that meeting said: "It almost happened."

The United States did not know that among the 42,000 Russian specialists in Cuba at the time of the showdown between Kennedy and Krushev, the on-the-spot field commanders in Cuba had been empowered to use the nuclear war-heads at their own discretion (without calling Moscow). And if Krushev had not backed down, the war was scheduled to begin within 48 hours.

We are not terribly interested in near misses. But, something out of that Havana meeting should interest us immensely.

Secretary McNamara, who spent the entire twelve days of that crisis in the Pentagon kept saying that when we face such a crisis now we must realize that we are talking about "the death not of thousands, or even millions, but of nations."

We are reminded of the one warning given by Our Lady at Fatima which has not yet befallen mankind: "Several entire nations will be annihilated."

In 1973 on the actual anniversary of Her miracle at

“Our Lady’s IPVS Image Comforts The People From St. Lucia’s – West Indies”

After much planning, the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue (IPVS) was scheduled to visit the West Indies in January 2001. Originally, the tour was to begin in St. Lucia on the 4th of January. However, for some unknown reason, the date was changed to the 8th of January and the tour was then scheduled to begin in Grenada, West Indies on the 4th of instead. Two days before leaving for the tour, a phone call was received from Dr. Courtney Bartholomew, the coordinator of the tour, with very distressing news.

During the New Year’s Eve Mass, at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, in St. Lucia, as worshippers were lining up in the aisles to receive Holy Communion, four men with matted locks of hair, known as Rastas (Rastafarians), burst into the Basilica and hacked the people with machetes, doused them with kerosene, then turned a flame thrower on them. An elderly Irish nun was killed and many people suffered

burns or deep gashes or were crushed in a stampede after the altar was set ablaze. The celebrant of the Mass, Rev. Charles Gaillard’s vestments went up in flames. With his entire body burnt, Rev. Gaillard died a few days later.

Witnesses reported that the men shouted: “The world is going to end and the time has come for what we have to do. There is so much corruption in the Catholic Church.”

On Saturday, January 6th the church reopened and the Holy Mass was celebrated for all of the victims of this horrendous crime.

On Monday, January 8th, the International Statue was processed from the airport to the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception to an overflowing crowd. Archbishop Kelvin Felix then celebrated the Holy Mass where we observed the burnt-blood stained floor and carpeting.

Did Our Lady change the date to the 8th of January to allow the special services to be held on the 6th of January for the victims of this crime? Two days later,

on the 8th of January, Our Lady came, through Her Image, to comfort and to give Her tender motherly love and hope to all present.

During a late dinner with Archbishop Kelvin Felix after the services, he stated he ran to the Basilica thinking that only a fire had started inside, but was not prepared to see what actually happened. After just one year of doing the scheduling for the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue, I came to realize that Our Lady does Her own scheduling. Her Image goes where She wants it to go and when She wants it to go. Our Lady will personally give a special grace to someone, somewhere, to bring Her Image where She wants to go.

(EDITOR’S NOTE: Although these four men claimed to be of the Rastafarians movement, the National Council for the Advancement of Rastafarians in St. Lucia are only concerned with peace and love. The four who committed this atrocity, were not of the real Rastafarian movement, but only with the intent of abusing its name.)

That day more than 1,000 people had gathered in front of the Kremlin together with the Archbishop and the Orthodox Patriarch. In the presence of all, Archbishop Kondruchewicz had crowned Our Lady of Fatima and thanked Her publicly for the freedom in Russia.

Now, sixteen years later, he once again found himself in the presence of the same miraculous statue in the very place



where Our Lady had actually made that promise. Upon entering the sanctuary, after the statue was in place, he once again crowned Our Blessed Mother in a moving act of piety.

In October, 2007 Archbishop Kondruchewicz was named Archbishop of Minsk by Pope Benedict XVI. He has entrusted this challenging assignment to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Let us keep him and the Catholic Church in Eastern Europe in our prayers.

It had been more than four years of wait for my religious worker’s visa to America to continue my apostolate with Our Lady through the Pilgrim Virgin of Fatima. I have been through a lot during those years. Having been denied three times at the United States Embassy in Manila, it was such a feeling of rejection and persecution.

I first saw the International Pilgrim statue in 2002 in the Philippines where I helped the custodians in their teaching mission in the far-flung areas of the country. They asked me to travel with them and assist in the spreading of the message of Our Mother in several countries in the Pacific like Taiwan, India, and Australia. The effort of getting me in the United States began as early as the year 2004 to make an easy entry to other Western countries. The third rejection dates back to the 13th of December of that same year. I did not choose any of the dates for an appointment but the consulate arranged it for whatever reason. The process took another three more years and on the 20th of February 2008, the interviewing officer finally said, “I guess today is your lucky day!” then handed me the visa to enter the Land of the Free. It was the feast day of Blessed Francisco and Blessed Jacinta! Thanks to these two little saints from Portugal. Well, I never realized the significance of the date those times. I was perhaps too emotional to even think about it. Either too sad about the rejections or too happy about the positive result. Honestly, it is only at this moment as I write this story that I finally looked back and as a hindsight it is indeed in God’s time that we get what we ask of Him.

Looking back, if I were granted a visa four years ago, I would not have known if I would had been blessed with a lovely wife and two wonderful kids.

I never had it my plans before but God placed it in my lap as if saying, “here, son, is what I want for you”. I was under the seminary formation for more five years since I was 16. Trained to be an apostle of Christ, even an alter-Christus to serve as a priest. But God has His mysterious design for me. This I believe is my vocation. They say, “a wrongly chosen vocation is never a vocation”. Yet this is what I have chosen rightly in faith. Actually, I have simply responded. I owe this vocation to Our Lady. This is the best way I could serve God. I am now a lay apostle and proud to be a “roamin’ catholic”!

These are the things, among many other things, that I should be grateful for. And I am. Truly I am grateful to God and to the instruments He is using, the people who are continuously saying yes to His will to make the message of Fatima known throughout all the world who make me a part of it. Travelling with Our Lady makes me share with the joy of Pope John Paul II when he visited Fatima “with the rosary in my hands, the name of Mary on my lips, and the canticle of mercy in my heart”! Like his papal motto, “Totus Tuus, O Maria” I am expressing my humble service in gratitude to God’s love. I am totally Yours, O Mary! All that I have, my family and my everything, I consecrate to you!

Now, you readers of this newsletter become part of my journey. I am at your service in giving you the updates on the travels of Our Mother through The Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima as one of Her custodians and your newsletter editor.

Fatima performed "so that all may believe," Our Lady appeared in Akita, Japan and said: "If men do not repent and better themselves, the Father will inflict a terrible punishment on all humanity. It will be a punishment greater than the deluge. Fire will fall from the sky and will wipe out a great part of humanity."

Little by little even small nations, even as small as Cuba, can trigger atomic destruction. Although Cuba is a small nation, because of it we came to the very brink of a nuclear war. Only God knows how many nations would have been destroyed.

And what is the situation at the beginning of the 21st century? After the dissolution of the Soviet Union in 1991, it was decided to destroy half of the 30,000 nuclear weapons in the former Soviet Republics. But to destroy them, with available equipment, would take ten years. Then by 2001, IF the destruction went ahead as agreed, 15,000 would still remain! And how many small nations will by then have acquired them?

At Fatima Our Lady said "several entire nations will be annihilated." At Akita She said: "Fire will fall from the sky and will wipe out a great part of humanity." To Lucia, in March of 1939, Our Lord said: "Ask, ask insistently for the promulgation of the Communion of reparation on the First Saturdays. The time is coming when the rigor of My Justice will punish the crimes of various nations. Some of them will be annihilated."

On October 13, 1973, Our Lady of Akita emphasized Her message with miracles of tears and blood. These miracles and messages were approved not only by the Bishop of the diocese but also upheld by the Episcopal Conference of Japan. They were the first apparitions to be approved by the Church in more than fifty years.

They reveal Our Lady as an anxious Mother who knows that after the changes in Russia and the relaxation of world tensions people might no longer realize the danger, might no longer really feel the urgency of reparation. She reminds us: Weapons capable of wiping out entire nations are still viable, spread in more and more areas. She says: "Fire will fall from the sky...The survivors will find themselves so desolate that they will envy the dead."

But as always She comes to save us. She comes with

hope. She says She has so far been able to hold back the chastisement because of those who have responded. But She tells us that now a SPECIAL response is needed. And we know from Her message of Fatima precisely what this is. Moreover She gives us St. Joseph as our protector even as he was the protector of the Holy Family. We are told at Akita:

"The more you offer this good intention (to respond to the message) the more difficult and numerous will be the obstacles. But St. Joseph will protect your work." We are engaged in a titanic spiritual battle. The angel at Akita said:

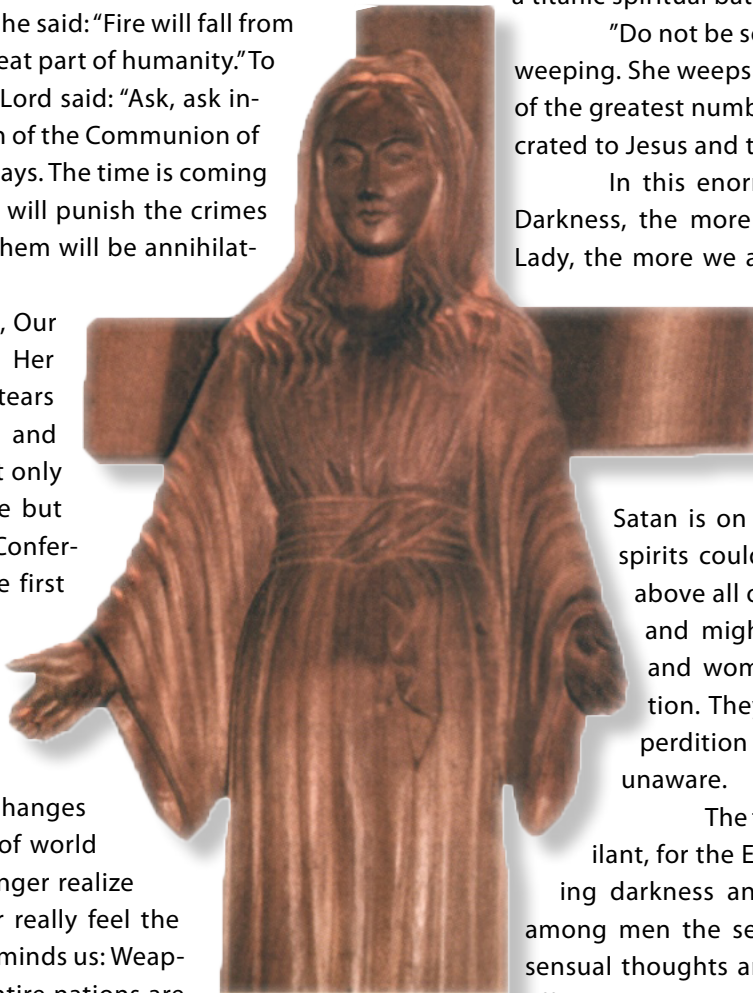

In this enormous struggle with the Powers of Darkness, the more we promote the message of Our Lady, the more we are certain to be the objects of Satan's most virulent attacks. But Our Lady promises us a special protection.

We must open our eyes to the ever old, ever new reality: We are indeed engaged in a great battle. Satan is on the loose and He and the infernal spirits could not accept that God placed man above all other creatures. With all their power and might they persecute and attack men and women of every age and of every nation. They spare no one. They drag souls to perdition while most of the world remains unaware.

The faithful should therefore remain vigilant, for the Evil One and his minions are spreading darkness and absurdities everywhere, sowing among men the seeds of hatred, of vain, proud and sensual thoughts and injecting in their minds worldly affairs and pleasures, giving them no time for spiritual thoughts. Indeed, the devil has succeeded in suppressing the truth and he has led billions of souls to eternal damnation.

Lucifer and the fallen angels are very wise and cunning. They know that if people were to know that they are the mas-



termind of all abominable offenses against the Most High, people would certainly not consent to their diabolical plans. Thus Satan disguises himself as an angel of light (2 Cor. 11:14). The Master of Deceit, he presents sins under attractive appearances.

In the Book of Sirach, we read: My son, if you come forward to serve the Lord, prepare yourself for temptation. Set your heart right and be steadfast, and do not be hasty in time of calamity. Cleave to Him and do not depart that you may be honored at the end of your life. Accept whatever is brought upon you, and in changes that humble you, be patient. Trust Him and He will help you, make your ways straight and hope in Him. (Sirach 2:1-6).

The same book tells us: Consider the ancient generations and see. Who ever trusted in the Lord and was put to shame? Or whoever persevered in the fear of the Lord and was forsaken? Or who ever called upon Him and was overlooked? For the Lord is compassionate and merciful. He forgives sins and saves in time of affliction (10:11).

That is the hopeful message of Fatima and Akita: "The Lord is compassionate and merciful. He forgives and saves in time of affliction."

“Mary: Queen of the New Creation”

Mary became the bearer of God’s presence into the world so many years ago. The Church, who is the bride of Christ, is the great Woman who gives birth to Jesus in the world today. Mary, being the first daughter of the Church perfectly reflects that. In her very person, She does what the Church does. She brings Jesus into the world. In each one of us, as members of that church, we find what our mission is: that our mission is to do what she did; to bring Jesus into the world. However, it is a twofold mission. On the one hand, Mary and the Church bring Jesus into the world but on the other hand, Mary and the Church also invite the world into Jesus. It goes both ways. She becomes that door through which God and humanity met. In her womb She brings God and humanity together. For Mary, this happens in her womb in the person of Jesus; for the Church it happened in the womb of the baptismal font where humanity and divinity mingle and we find ourselves living forever. The promise that God gives to us comes through the Church.

Mary shows us how we can hold Jesus in the world; that our role then is to be this woman, our role then is to follow this woman; our role is to look at what the Mother of Christ looks like and to take that into our lives. els constantly, bringing Mary and her message to countless people. We see thousands coming forward to receive the scapular, and thousands pledging to do the simple things Our Lady asked of us in her Peace Plan from Heaven.

As the IPVS custodian I have seen the distribution of about half-million scapulars. People are consecrating themselves to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and committing themselves to the fulfillment right here in America, just by going from parish to parish, inviting people to come and feel the presence of Mary, and hear her words.

The best part of being statue custodian is seeing so many people who are hungry for this message of hope. People are concerned that our society has degenerated so much in recent years. Everywhere I have taken the statue, people have gathered and listened intently to Our Lady's message and have responded to the call for prayer and penance with joy. They see that what we say makes sense. In each diocese we tour, the crowds increase day by day during the 21-day tour, because so many wish to come again and hear Mary's consoling message. In Gary, Indiana our closing day was in a large church. Over two thousand people attended.

We were scheduled to be in the Belleville, IL diocese in September 1993. The timing was perfect for Our Mother to console the victims of the flood. We were in Los Angeles, CA in March, 1994, just after the earthquake. Our Mother Mary showed her loving presence with a visit of the IPVS. These were scheduled long before the disasters struck.

I have fond memories, too, of Western Canada, where we took the statue during the summer of 1994. Great devotion and trust in Mary was shown there. One day, when I was at a school,

one third-grade boy was seated with a teacher's aide on each side and another behind him. I was told that he suffered from hyperactivity and short attention span so acutely that he was unable to pass his classes. They feared that he might disrupt the Fatima presentation. But, he remained quiet. The next day his mother called to tell us that although her son usually has so much trouble remembering his lessons, he had repeated, practically verbatim, the talk I had given on the message of Fatima!

School children are a pleasure to address. They relate to the children of Fatima.

When I took the statue to the El Paso, TX diocese in November 1994, so many people came to the airport to welcome us that the airport corridors were clogged. Knights of Columbus helped open a way to the entrance and the airport manager asked us to leave quickly because no one could move.

Standing Room Only

We visited twenty-three parish-

es and everyone was overcrowded. Even when we came to the very small town of Kermit and arrived at midnight. Although this was an unscheduled stop and we had decided at the last minute to go there, we found standing room only! At St. Therese's Presidio, they held services in a large hall because the church would be too small. Sixteen hundred people attended. Their church seats one hundred and fifty!

While in El Paso, we arranged to go across the Rio Grande to Juarez, Mexico for an all-night vigil. We were met at the border and had a procession several miles down the main street and over to Diving Providence Church. The church was jammed full when we arrived at 1:00 p.m. with about six hundred in procession! So with even the aisles packed with people, we began the vigil. As some left, others came. With the aisles jammed, Mariachi musicians performed for Our Lady at 7:00 p.m. and Mass followed. The church was still full at midnight! After the 6:00 a.m. Mass, Mariachi musicians again sang to Mary. As the vigil ended at noon, the church was overflowing with people! Twenty thousand people had turned out for the overnight visit of the IPVS at Juarez!

"Our Lady of the Internet and of the Highway"
