FATIMA AND SOCIALISM

In 1917, Czarist Russia was changed into the Red Empire of Communism through the Red Revolution, becoming the Soviet Union and the first communist state in history.

That very same year Our Lady appeared six times to three little shepherd children, Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco in Fatima, Portugal, presenting to them a spiritual plan for peace in the world which at that time was in the midst of World War I. During the third apparition on July 13th, after showing them the vision of Hell, Our Lady said very sadly:

"You have seen hell, where the souls of poor sinners go. It is to save them that God wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If you do what I tell you, many souls will be saved, and there will be peace."

"This war will end, but if men do not refrain from offending God, another and more terrible war will begin during the pontificate of Pius XI. When you see a night that is lit by a strange and unknown light [this occurred on January 28, 1938], you will know it is the sign God gives you that He is about to punish the world with war and with hunger, and by the persecution of the Church and the Holy Father."

"To prevent this, I shall come to ask that Russia be consecrated to my Immaculate Heart, and I shall ask that on the First Saturday of every month Communions of reparation be made in atonement for the sins of the world. If my wishes are fulfilled, Russia will be converted and there will be peace; if not, then Russia will spread her errors throughout the world, bringing new wars and persecutions of the Church; the good will be martyred



and the Holy Father will have much to suffer; certain nations will be annihilated. But in the end my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me, and she will be converted, and the world will enjoy a period of peace. In Portugal, the faith will always be preserved..."

The "errors of Russia" spoken of by Our Blessed Mother are none other than Communism and Marxist Socialism. In the late 1800s, Pope Leo XIII in his encyclical Quod Apostolici Muneris defined Communism as "the fatal plague which insinuates itself into the very marrow of human society only to bring about its ruin." Further Church proclamations stated that Communism is not only a movement subversive to the Faith but total and complete apostasy from the Catholic Faith, for Communism means materialism and a denial of God and His rights. Communism is not only against private ownership and social classes but also the natural

order and the supernatural order. In the Communistic system the State is everything and the individual and family are nothing and God does not exist. Communism's goals are to abolish morality, the family and individual liberty. Communism calls good bad and bad good.

For decades, many Americans believed that the tenants of Communism and Marxism were not possible to be spread in our land of freedom protected by the United States Constitution. We felt secure that we were protected from such scourges and that when praying the Rosary and living the message of Our Lady of Fatima, it was being done to help those countries already under that dictatorship.

In 1947 Professor William Thomas Walsh authored one of the first books in English on the Fatima events simply titled Our Lady of Fatima. In the book he recounts an interview he had with Sr. Lucia a year before. Regarding the Collegial Consecration of Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Sr. Lucia said: Our Lady wants is that the Pope and all the bishops in the world shall consecrate Russia to her Immaculate Heart on one special day. If this is done, she will convert Russia and there will be peace. If it is not done, the errors of Russia will spread through every country in the world." Walsh then asked:

"Does this mean, in your opinion, that every country, without exception, will be overcome by Communism?" And Sister Lucia answered: "Yes." Still pressing the issue, Walsh then asked explicitly about the United States of America, adding: "and does that mean the United States of America, too?" Whereupon

Sister Lucia responded one more time with "yes."

If anyone has doubt that Russia has spread her errors, consider the on-going and rapid disintegration of morality and the family and an overall disregard for God and His Commandments. Take note of world events of the past year especially in our Country: freedoms slowly being stripped away under the guise of the common good, shutdowns, mandates cultivating fear in people, riots, calls to defund the police, destruction of property, looting, lying, cheating, stealing, The Great Reset, "cancel culture" and secular governments dictating how worship is to be observed in our churches.

Several of the predictions of Our Lady at Fatima sadly came to pass. World War II began twenty-two years after the Fatima Apparitions, there have been numerous other wars, the Catholic Church continues to be persecuted from within and from without and there is no peace. How did the world arrive at this point? The answer may sound simple but for over one-hundred years a vast majority of Catholics have not heeded Our Lady of Fatima's request for reparation for sin and the daily Rosary.

An important spiritual remedy against the further spread of the plague of Marxist Socialism and Communism is the First Saturday Communion of Reparation.

On December 10, 1925, Our Lady appeared together with the Child Jesus to Sister Lucia in the Dorothean Convent at Tuy, Spain. The Child Jesus, pointing to the Heart of His Mother said: "Have pity on this Heart, continually tormented by ungrateful men, with nobody to make

reparation. Our Lady added: "Look, my child, at my Heart surrounded with thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude! You, at least console me."

Our Lady then gave the following requirements to observe the devotion of the five consecutive First Saturdays, all being done with the intention of making reparation to Mary's

Immaculate Heart.:

- 1.) Confession (which could be made some time before or after the First Saturday provided one receives Holy Communion in the state of grace).
- 2.) The reception of Holy Communion.
- 3.) Recitation of five decades of the Holy Rosary.
- 4.) Keeping Our Lady company

for 15 minutes while meditating on one or more of the mysteries of the Rosary.

Our Lady promised that She would assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for salvation all those who make this devotion. Once the Five First Saturdays have been completed it is praiseworthy to keep observing them each month out of love for Our Lady and to help

usher in the triumph and reign of Her Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart! All of us must do our part in helping to avert the other prophecies of Our Lady of Fatima which have yet to be fulfilled such as various nations being annihilated, and in making the United States of America once more "a Nation under God...with liberty and justice for all!" Help console your Mother. Help save the world!

Our Lord's Love for All Mankind


On one occasion, I heard these words: (Jesus to St. Faustina)

"And even if the sins of souls were as dark as night, when the sinner turns to My mercy, he gives Me the greatest praise and is the glory of My Passion. When a soul extols My goodness, Satan trembles before it and flees to the very bottom of hell." (378)

St. Faustina recorded all her visions and conversations with Jesus in her diary called, **Divine Mercy in My Soul**. Here she wrote the words of Jesus about the graces that would pour out on anyone who prayed before the image:

"I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I, Myself, will defend [that soul] as My own glory." (48)

"Tell [all people] ...that I am Love and Mercy itself. When a soul approaches Me with Trust, I fill it with an abundance of graces it can not contain them within itself, but radiates them to other souls." (1074)

"Souls who spread the honor of My mercy I shield through their entire lives as a tender mother her infant, and at the hour of death I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Savior." (1075)

Jesus promised me that, "With souls that have recourse to My mercy and with those that glorify and proclaim My great mercy to others, I will deal according to My infinite mercy at the hour of their death." (379)

Regarding Divine Mercy Sunday, Jesus told St. Faustina, "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (699).

"Oh, what great graces I will grant to souls who say this chaplet; the very depths of My tender mercy are stirred for the sake of those who say the chaplet." (848)

"My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one." (1541) When one is seriously ill and near death, Jesus said:

"Say unceasingly the chaplet that I have taught you. Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death. ... Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only

once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy." (687)

"When this chaplet is said by the bedside of a dying person ... unfathomable mercy envelops the soul, and the very depths of My tender mercy are moved for the sake of the sorrowful Passion of My Son." (811)

"The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death." (754) marian.org/whatwedo/divinemercy.php

How to Pray this Chaplet

Using the Holy Rosary, begin with one Our Father, Hail Mary, and the Apostles Creed. On the OUR FATHER beads say:

"Eternal Father, I offer you the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world." On the HAIL MARY beads you will say the following words:

"For the sake of His sorrowful passion (the respondent will say) have mercy on us and on the whole world." "In conclusion, three times you will recite these words: 'Holy God, Holy Mighty


One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and the whole world." (476)

THE HOLY SACRIFICE OF THE MASS

"O, poor deceived people, what are you doing? Why do you not crowd the churches in order that you might attend as many Masses as possible? Why do you not take as models the angels who, whenever Mass is being celebrated, descend in legions from Paradise and kneel before the altar in reverence that they may efficaciously intercede for us?" St. Leonard of Port Maurice

During the entire celebration of the Mass, we must join actively and responsibly. Remember, we are in the presence of the King of Kings, Lord of Lords, and Creator of the entire universe. Ask yourself, am I properly dressed to meet the King of Kings? Is my cell phone on mute? Am I aware of the reverence I must show my singular God? St. Josemaria Escriva, founder of the Opus Dei movement, once commented that when we find the length of the Mass too long, it indicates that "our love may be too short."

The Mass, in reality, is the Sacramental Celebration of the Paschal Mystery. It is the re-enactment of Our Lord's act of Redemption which He suffered by His life and death on the cross. Better stated by the Catholic Church, it is the Church in heaven and on earth. (233)

The Devotion of praying Three Hail Mary's each day was revealed to St. Melchtilde while she was beseeching Our Blessed Mother to assist her in her hour of death. Our Lady appeared to her and said:

"I will, certainly. But I also want you to say three special Hail Mary's to me every day."

"The first Hail Mary will be in honor of God the Father, Whose omnipotence raised my soul so high above every other creature that after God I have the greatest power in heaven and on earth. In the hour of your death, I will use that power of God the Father to keep any hostile power far from you.

"The second Hail Mary will be said in honor of the Son of God Who communicated His inscrutable wisdom to me. In the hour of your death I will fill your soul with the light of that wisdom so that all the darkness of ignorance and error will be dispelled."

"The third Hail Mary will be in honor of God the Holy Ghost. Who filled my soul with the sweetness of His love and tenderness and mercy. In your last hour I will then change the bitterness of death into divine sweetness and delight."

Our Blessed Mother also revealed to St. Gertrude the Great:

"To any soul who faithfully prays the Three Hail Mary's, I will appear at the hour of death in a splendor so extraordinary that it will fill the soul with heavenly consolation."

Numerous examples show how agreeable the three Hail Mary's Devotion is to the Divine Mother and what special graces it draws, during life and at the hour of death, on those who never omit it for a single day.

(St. Pope Pius X gave his Apostolic Blessings to this practice and the devotion was raised to the Arch-confraternity by Pope Benedict XV.)

~ THE ROSARY ~ A VISION OF ROSES



In "The Secret of the Rosary," St. Louis DeMontfort also wrote about a young Friar whom he had learned about through the chronicles of Saint Francis. The Friar prayed the Rosary every day before dinner. One day, he hadn't yet prayed it when the dinner bell rang, so he received permission from the Monastery Superior to go to his cell to pray it before eating.

"After he had been gone a long time the Superior sent another Friar to fetch him, and he found him in his room bathed in a heavenly light facing Our Lady who had two angels with her," wrote St. Louis De Montfort. "Beautiful roses kept issuing from his mouth at each Hair Mary; the angels took them one by one, placing

them on Our Lady's head, and she smilingly accepted them. Finally two other Friars who had been sent to find out what happened to the first two saw the same lovely scene, and Our Lady did not go away until the whole Rosary had been said."

In the same book, St Louis De Montfort also explained the meaning behind that miracle. "The word Rosary means 'Crown of Roses,' that is to say that every time people say the Rosary devoutly, they place a crown of one hundred and fifty-three red roses and sixteen white roses upon the heads of Jesus and Mary." The saint wrote. "Being heavenly flowers these roses will never fade or lose their exquisite beauty."

CHURCH GRANTS PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH

The Apostolic Penitentiary issues a Decree granting plenary indulgences for the year of St. Joseph proclaimed by Pope Francis The special year will last from 8 December 2020 to 8 December 2021.

Conditions for the plenary indulgence

The plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the Pope's intentions) to Christians who, with a spirit detached from any sin, participate in the Year of St. Joseph on these occasions and manners indicated by the Apostolic Penitentiary:

- The plenary indulgence is granted to those who will meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer, or take part in a Spiritual Retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph. "St. Joseph, an authentic man of faith, invites us", the decree reads, "to rediscover our filial relationship with the Father, to renew fidelity to prayer, to listen and correspond with profound discernment to God's will."
- The indulgence can also be obtained by those who, following St. Joseph's example, will perform a spiritual or corporal work of mercy. St. Joseph "encourages us

to rediscover the value of silence, prudence and loyalty in carrying out our duties," the decree notes.

- The recitation of the Holy Rosary in families and among engaged couples is another way of obtaining indulgences, in order that "all Christian families may be stimulated to recreate the same atmosphere of intimate communion, love and prayer that was in the Holy Family."
- Everyone who entrusts their daily activity to the protection of St. Joseph, and every faithful who invokes the intercession of St. Joseph so that those seeking work can find dignifying work can also obtain the plenary indulgence. On 1 May 1955, Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of St. Joseph "with the intent that the dignity of work be recognized by all, and that it inspires social life and laws, based on the fair distribution of rights and duties."
- The plenary indulgence is also granted to the faithful who will recite the Litany to St. Joseph (for the Latin tradition), or the Akathistos to St. Joseph (for the Byzantine tradition), or any other prayer to St. Joseph proper



to the other liturgical traditions, for the persecuted Church ad intra and ad extra, and for the relief of all Christians suffering all forms of persecution. Because, the decree notes, "the flight of

the Holy Family to Egypt shows us that God is there where man is in danger, where man suffers, where he runs away, where he experiences rejection and abandonment."
