Nigerian Bishop - Vision Of Christ Reveals Rosary Will Defeat Boko Haram

A Nigerian bishop says that he has seen Christ in a vision and now knows that the rosary is the key to ridding the country of the Islamist terrorist organization Boko Haram.

and he in turn reached out for it. "As soon as I received the sword, it turned into a rosary," the bishop said, adding that Jesus then told him three times: "Boko Haram is gone."

"I didn't need any prophet to give me the explanation," he said. "It was clear that with the rosary we would be able to expel Boko Haram."

The bishop said he didn't want to tell anyone, but "felt that the Holy Spirit was pushing him to do so." He started with the priest of his diocese, and then told participants in a conference in Madrid, Spain which was dedicated to gathering ideas on how to preserve the Christian presence in nations where they are the most persecuted.

Bishop Dashe leads the Diocese of Maiduguri, located in north-eastern Nigeria's Borno State, one of the worst hit areas. It was here that the terrorists seized more than 250 girls from a school in Chibok, most of which have never been seen again. Just last month, five suicide bombers killed 54 people and wounded hundreds of others where the bishop lives. In January, more than 150 people were slaughtered as they tried to flee to safety.



Bishop Dashe said he has a strong devotion to Christ's mother, and that "I never joke with 'Mamma Mary.' I know She is here with us."

And he is not the only Nigerian bishop putting the future of the country in the hands of Mary. The nation's bishops' conference has consecrated the country to Mary twice in recent years.

Bishop Dashe believes that one day his diocese will completely recover and grow, thanks to Her intercession.


"These terrorists...think that by burning our churches, burning our structures, they will destroy Christianity. Never," Bishop Dashe

told several hundred people from the Congress. "It may take a few months or a few years...but 'Boko Haram is gone.'"

He later told EWTN News that "prayer, particularly the prayer of the rosary, is what will deliver us from the claws of this demon, the demon of terrorism. And, of course, it is working."

Terrorism is just an act, a means to an end. It is what is driving the terrorism that is the real demon.

The cruel persecution they face now, may be our own soon enough.




Bishop, Oliver Dashe Doeme

Bishop Oliver Dashe Doeme says he is being driven by a God-given mandate to lead others in praying the rosary until the extremist group disappears.

someone said recently "one of the great uses of Twitter and Facebook will be to prove at the Last Day that prayerlessness was not from lack of time."



Our Lady of Fatima, Our Mother comes to us in Sacramento



I wanted to share with you how the visit of Our Lady of Fatima deeply touched me and my parishioners during Her visit here during the month of March, 2015 to the Sacramento, CA diocese.

I was so excited about the visitation of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima and welcomed such an honorable guest from above. I prayed to God to give to me a sign from Heaven that he is happy with this event. He answered my prayers abundantly. A few days before the visit of the statue I re-established a connection with my good friend, a priest from Ukraine. On the day of the visitation when my parishioners were praying the rosary, out of

the blue I decided to chat with him via Skype. It was such a great experience, not only to hear his voice, but also to see him. He told me how people suffer because of the war and political situation in his country during the past few months. I told him we would pray for peace in Ukraine. I decided to go to the church with my phone and asked him to be quiet because the parishioners were praying. He asked me to particularly pray for our priests. I went into the church and one of the parishioners had begun the Luminous Mysteries. He was on the fifth decade, which is the Institution of the Eucharist, and then, I don't know why, but I put him on speaker and I asked him to lead us in the prayer. So he said the first part of the Hail Mary in Ukrainian. Our people could hear his voice and our congregation answered the second part of the Hail Mary in English. It was a great sense of joy and solidarity with people in the Ukraine and the United States all praying for peace. When we finished the prayer, I realized that one of the main themes of the Blessed Mother when she appeared in 1917 was a request to pray for peace and particularly for Russia.

My friend, Father Wladyslaw, and his family suffered greatly because of his beliefs. His younger brother was killed by KGB in a very mysterious way and they never received any answer as to what the motive of this horrible tragedy was. He received his first holy communion underground but through great and strong faith of his parents, not only he, but also his older brother Celestyn, joined the only Catholic Seminary in the former Soviet Union in Riga, Latvia and became priests in 1989 when communism was already shaking and this evil empire was

approaching its end.

I am so thankful to Carl and Victor, the members of the team, that brought the statue to our parish and gave a wonderful talk about the message from Fatima. Our parishioners were praying all the time in silence and we could feel the gentle presence of our Heavenly Mother.

The Power Of The Holy Rosary

A ROSARY WONDER.

In 1978, the Rosary saved a college girl from dying at the hands of the in-famous serial killer Ted Bundy.

Ted Bundy had just murdered or fatally injured all the other girls in a college sorority house, and then entered her room—but some unexplainable force made him stop, drop his weapon and flee.

That particular girl had promised her grandmother she would pray the Rosary every night, and when Bundy entered her room, she was still clutching the Rosary beads in her hand.

The date was January 15, the time approximately 3 a.m., when the horrific serial killer –on the loose after a prison escape – entered a sorority house and killed two sleeping women, before searching for other victims.

The unnamed girl awoke to a man standing over her with a bat. When she opened her hands, Bundy looked at the rosary beads in them, and fled, notes another account; such is the power of our Mother's protective mantle!

This was related to a priest, Monsignor William Kerr, of Tallahassee, Florida, who was called by the police to accompany them to the Chi Omega sorority house at Florida State University – where the girl was found catatonic and in fact would only speak to the priest (who died in May of 2009). Monsignor in his turn had related it to a priest named Fr. Gabriel Gillen, OP.

When Monsignor Kerr approached the near catatonic girl, she told him her grandmother had made her promise before going off to college that she would always

pray the Rosary every night before bed for protection even if she fell asleep praying it – which she had that night; thus, when he entered, the beads were still clutched in her hands.

Bundy eventually confessed to over thirty murders, although the actual total remains unknown, with estimates of twenty-six to over a hundred (the general figure set around 35). Typically, notes a web biography, "Bundy would bludgeon his victims, then strangle them to death," sometimes along with sexual assault.

Ironically, when Ted Bundy was on death row, awaiting execution for his crimes, he asked Monsignor Kerr to serve as a spiritual counselor, and the priest took the opportunity to ask about that terrible night. Bundy explained that when he entered the girl's

room, he had fully intended on murdering her; some mysterious power was preventing him from doing so.

There are very powerful promises attached to praying the Rosary," notes Father Esper. And not only does it aid our own spiritual growth—it also undermines the kingdom of Satan. The famous Vatican exorcist Father Gabriel Amorth testified, "One day a colleague of mine heard the devil say during an exorcism, "Every Hail Mary is like a blow on my head. If Christians knew how powerful the Rosary was, it would be my end." Padre Pio who called the Rosary an extraordinarily powerful weapon against Satan, once said, "The Rosary is the weapon for these times." And so we pray.

The Message Of Fatima In Our Lady's Own Words

The Rest of the Secret

Immediately after the words of July 13th, quoted in our last Newsletter, Our Lady added: "The dogma of the faith will always be kept in Portugal." Then immediately Our Lady showed the children two visions that were still kept secret until they were revealed June 26, 2000, by order of Pope John Paul II. Lucia describes them in these words:

At the left of Our Lady and a little above, we saw an Angel with flaming sword in his left hand; flashing it gave out flames that looked as though they would set the world on fire. But they died out in contact with the splendor that Our Lady radiated towards him from Her right hand. Pointing to the earth with his right hand, the Angel cried out in a loud voice: "Penance, Penance, Penance!"

And we saw, in an immense light that is God (something similar to how people appear in a mirror when they pass in front of it), a bishop dressed in white (we had the impression it was the Holy Father).

"We saw other bishops, priests, men and women religious, going up a steep mountain at the top of which was a big Cross of rough-hewn trunks as of a cork tree with bark.

Before reaching there the Holy Father passed through a big city half in ruins and half trembling

with halting step, afflicted with pain and sorrow, he prayed for the souls of the corpses he met on his way.

Having reached the top of the mountain, on his knees at the foot of the big Cross he was killed by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows at him. And in the same way there died, one after another, the other bishops, priests, men and women Religious, and various lay people of different ranks and positions.

Beneath the two arms of the Cross there were two Angels, each with a crystal aspersion in his hand, in which they gathered up the blood of the Martyrs and with it sprinkled the souls that were making their way to God.

Questions:

What does the vision mean?

The Vatican document, in which the secret was released, explains: "The angel with the flaming sword on the left of the Mother of God recalls similar images in the Book of Revelation (the Apocalypse). This represents the threat of judgment which looms over the world. Today the prospect that the world might be reduced to ashes by a sea of fire no longer seems pure fantasy. Man himself, with his inventions, has forged the flaming sword."

What does Sister Lucia

herself say the vision means?


In the very beginning of the same document re-releasing the secret, the Secretary of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith recalled that on May 12, 1982, Sister Lucia wrote to the Holy Father: "The third part of the secret refers to Our Lady's words: 'If not (Russia) will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. The good will be martyred; the Holy Father will have much to

suffer; various nations will be annihilated.'" (Emphasis added.)

Sister Lucia added: "*If we have not yet seen the complete fulfillment of the final part of this prophecy, we are going towards it little by little with great strides.*"

The secret deals with the present world crisis in faith and morality. It is a repetition of the final words spoken by Our Lady at Fatima:

"Men must cease offending God, who is so much offended."
